Child Protection Policy

Policy Statement

The aim of the ACKB Child Protection Policy is to promote good practice:

Providing children and young people with appropriate safety and protection whilst in the care of ACKB

1. ACKB has a duty of care to safeguard all children involved in its activities and clubs from harm. All children have a right to protection, and the needs of disabled people and others who may be particularly vulnerable must be taken into account.
2. ACKB will ensure the safety and protection of all children involved in its activities and clubs through adherence of the Child Protection guidelines adopted by ACKB as advised by the Child Protection in Sport Unit.
3. A child is defined as a person under the age of 18 in accordance with the Children Act 1989.
4. All Instructors, either newly qualifying or joining ACKB will be required to have a Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) Enhanced Disclosure check, to ensure suitability to work with children. Any person refusing this check will not be permitted to instruct within our Association.
5. Instructors are advised to familiarise themselves with their own Local Area Child Protection Committee.
